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STEP 2

Remove the seat. Remove the liner from the inside of the Tour Pak by removing the two acorn nuts inside the pouch and lifting the liner out. PIC 1 Remove the four bolts that attach the Tour Pak to the trike deck. Set this hardware aside, it may be reused. Cover the trike with a blanket in the seat area and gently lift the Tour Pak and set it on the blanket. PIC 2

STEP 3


Determine the left arm hoop (sitting on the bike) from the right. When attached to the bracket and folded into the riding position, the mounting hole for the arm rest pad will point almost straight back PIC 3. Also, from the underside, the bevel of the casting stop will go towards the center of the bike. PIC 4

STEP 4

Attach the left arm hoop to the left mounting bracket using a supplied $5/16''-24 \times 1-1/4''$ Hex Head Cap Screw, steel M8 washer, M8 small diameter white washer from the bottom side of the bracket PIC 5. Next, place a large diameter white washer over the Hex Head Cap Screw threads from the top side of the bracket PIC 6. Place the arm hoop, then a M8 small diameter white washer, M8 steel washer and nylock nut over the threads PIC 7. Left side shown.

NOTE: See exploded view FIG 1.

NOTE: After installation, you will be able to adjust the tension on the arms by tightening or loosening this nut using a 1/2" open end wrench to hold the Hex Head Cap Screw from the underside of the mounting bracket and the supplied 1/2" Offset Wrench from the top side to adjust the nut.







STEP 5 Place the left and right side armrest brackets on the trike deck. To ease installation in the stock location, use a nylon cable tie through the slot in the Tour Pak mounting bracket on the trike and around the armrest bracket. PIC 8 Line up the stock position mounting holes in the armrest bracket with the holes in the

Tour Pak bracket and tighten the cable tie to hold it in place.

STEP 6 Place the Tour Pak over the armrest mounting brackets. Line up the holes in the Tour Pak with the holes in the mounting brackets. Insert one of the supplied

1/4"-20 X 1-1/2" Button Socket Cap Screws in each hole. Tighten securely. After installing the Tour Pak, the tie straps may be removed. PIC 8 Proceed to

Step 11.

FOR RELOCATING THE TOUR PAK

STEP 7 Choose the mounting holes on the brackets that will give you the desired Tour Pak position. The front holes in the brackets will move the Tour Pak approximately two inches further back than stock. The second holes will move it approximately one inch further back than stock. The rear holes will move it ahead approximately one inch. Left bracket shown. PIC 9

STEP 8 After determining the Tour Pak mounting position, insert one of the 1/4"-20 nylock nuts (with flat side of nut into the bracket first) in the four recessed holes on the underside of the mounting brackets. PIC 10

NOTE: You may want to put a piece of masking tape over the recessed hole after placing the nut in it to keep the nut from falling out when the brackets are turned over for installation.

STEP 9 Align the mounting brackets on the trike deck in the position determined in Step 7 and attach them to the body using the four stock Button Socket Cap Screws, removed in Step 2, and the supplied 1/4" Flat Washers. Tighten securely.


STEP 10 Set the Tour Pak on the brackets. Using the included 1/4"-20 X 7/8" Button Socket Cap Screws, attach the Tour Pak to the mounting brackets. Tighten securely.

STEP 11 Install the arm rest pad without the drink holder to the left arm rest hoop by inserting the post on the bottom of the pad into the arm hoop. Using one of the supplied 1/4"-20 X 5/8" Oval Screws. attach the arm rest pad to the hoop. Repeat for the right side using the pad with the drink holder.


TWO INCHES BACK

INSTALLATION

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STEP 12 Use installer supplied to secure the passenger intercom port to the hand rail (PIC 11) or your desired location.



Secure all wiring from the newly installed and/or from existing parts, away from any moving parts, pinch points or extreme heat. Küryakyn WILL NOT issue a warranty on any electrical component that fails due to pinched, crimped, broken, abraded, melted or frayed wires.

INSTALL RUBBER PLUGS HERE

Install the Black Rubber Threaded Plugs into the arm hoops PIC 12. Install the Tour Pak liner. Install the seat.



STEP 13
